Activities that vary per season (extra fee)

Each season brings you a variety of activities which you can take part of. We provide the activities according to the season such as farming, foraging for sansei vegetables and skiing. Prices vary therefore we ask you to please confirm when making reservations.

- Farm activities such as planting or harvesting rice, picking apples, peaches and muscat grapes
- Mushroom or sansei vegetables activities in the mountains
- River fishing and making smoked river fish.
- Local Aomori cuisine cooking classes such as meals using local mushrooms, bamboo shoots and vegetables. Also a Tsugaru soup called Keno Jiru which consists of finely chopped local vegetables and the broth is dried kelp stock
