Heartwarming Lodging Experience

Tsukiyano Irorian" offers a farmhouse living in a renovated 70-year-old silkworm farmhouse in the Tsukiyano district of Minakami Town, Gunma Prefecture, the headwaters of the Tone River. Making the most of the plentiful soil and water, the farmers spend time and effort to grow seasonal vegetables without using pesticides as much as possible to "pick," "cook," and "eat". We offer a casual experience of farmhouse living that is close to nature. Lodging in this real farmhouse is limited to one group (4 people) per day. Each group can enjoy the inn as if they were visiting a friend's house, picking home-grown vegetables, and cooking them together on the spot, or sharing a pot of hot pot and sake around the sunken irori hearth.

Activities (please contact the owners regarding fees)

The innkeeper is also a graduate of the Green Tourism Instructor Training School offered by Machimura Koryu Kiko. Farming activity: 2,000 yen/person (2 sessions, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. The activity lasts approximately 3 hours. You will learn how to pick fruits and vegetables of the season while learning how to harvest them. Not only harvesting, but also planting seeds and seedlings, and rice planting are also available.

Gunma Local Food Culture: 3,000 yen / (about 2 hours) Okirikomi" (simmered noodle dish) (registered as an intangible folk cultural property of Gunma Prefecture) is a local dish that inherits the traditional taste of Gunma, where the wheat culture flourished. Especially, cooking using plenty of seasonal vegetables. We go to the field and harvest daikon radish, carrots, burdock root, taro, leeks, etc., and use freshly picked vegetables to make the dish. (You can also try your hand at making udon noodles.) This warm and nutritious meal is healthy in the cold winter.

Other Activities: Wood-chopping, making strawberry jam, takuan (pickled radish), umeboshi (pickled plum), etc., depending on the season.
