## Dining around an irori hearth in an 100 year old house

Ichirino Kogen Hotel Roan is a hot springs inn at the foot of the sacred mountain, Hakusan one of the three famous mountains in Japan. You will be in touch with nature (what we call "shinrin yoku") while bathing in an open-air bath with tatami matt flooring. Here you can enjoy the hot natural springs flowing directly from its water source, and dine on locally produced food at the charcoal irori hearth in an old traditional Japanese setting of an 100 year old house. Especially popular is wild game meat- bear, wild boar and deer accompanied with wild sansai vegetables and locally grown organic vegetables. They also operate Yamazaki Ryokan, a secluded hot springs inn. (<http://iwanma-onsen.jp>)
