The inn is located in Kiso Fukushima, a post town on the Nakasendo Road dotted with historical sites Each season will bring you a different activity at this inn. In spring you can forge wild vegetables such as butterbur, bracken, cinnamon fern and bamboo shoots. In summer, go fishing, autumn is for foraging for mushrooms and chestnuts and sledding in winter.

Surrounding the area is the famous Kiso, a post town that flourished on the Nakasendo Road and many historical sites. Ontake and Kaida Kogen Ski Resorts are also nearby, so during winter you can enjoy snow sports. The fire of the old irori hearth warms your body tired from skiing. On site, there is the ruins of Matsuoyama Matsuo-ji Temple which was written about in the diary of Yamamura Daikan Yashiki. In the spring, the old trees that are the pride of the guest house, including the large cherry blossoms, the double cherry blossoms, the weeping cherry blossoms along with flowering pheasant's eye, daffodils, tulips, and wisteria.

The annexed main building is 130-years-old with a renovated bathroom and toilet.

# You can also enjoy each season with the flowers blooming all year round

Around the inn, flowers such as Selaginella Tamariscina, peregrina (white), phlox, anemone, Asiatic plantain, daffodils, Japanese kerria, trout lily, Japanese hyacinth and other flowers bloom. Year round activities such as wild vegetable foraging, snowshoeing, digging for bamboo shoots, picking Japanese mugwort and Japanese lady bell, Japanese angelica tree sprouts, harvesting chestnuts and mushrooms, fishing, collecting insects, playing tag in the snow, You can also take pleasure in storytelling and kamishibai (story illustrated with picture cards).

## Tour Kisoji with various accommodation plans

The 2 Rooms are equipped with a refrigerator, microwave, gas stove, washing machine, rice cooker, pots and dishes. At the grounds you can have a BBQ. Please use Minhsuku Matsuo as a base to explore the Kisoji area.
