

**1 group per day in a renovated old traditional home**

For a long time, the owners had lived in the city however they moved to the husband's hometown to take care of his parents. Instead being satisfied with their own migration, they dreamed of creating a hometown that connects the city and the countryside, and opened a Minpaku (lodging in their private residence) in 2010 as the first step toward realizing their dream. The building used for accommodation was the husband's parents' residence and it has been renovated. Only one group a day can be booked, so that you can spend a relaxing time with children or elderly people who need nursing care. In addition to the nostalgic and calm floor arrangement unique to country homes, it features a kamado stove where you can cook delicious rice and a kitchen with a large table.

**Wheelchair accessible**

The accommodations are wheelchair accessible and supportive for the elderly and people with disabilities. The restrooms and bedroom are also wheelchair-accessible. There is also a bath that can be used in a wheelchair in the main building. In addition, as a part of our activities as an NPO, and there are volunteers who support us as needed, so it is a friendly inn for the elderly and disabled.

**Tailor made itinerary**

In order for their guests enjoy their stay, they are asked in advance what they want to do in their hometown village and the owners will tailor make a personal plan. Guests can also include requests such as "I want to walk on Kumano Kodo", "I want to play in the river", "I want to fish", "Zazen at the temple", "Kayaking experience", etc. You can also participate in local events such as morning markets and mochimaki (rice cake throwing).
