It is also known as the birthplace of soy sauce in Japan, and this town with soy sauce breweries was listed as "Preservation Districts for Groups of Important Historic Buildings" in 2006.

Picking mandarin oranges and making sanpokan fruit jam are also popular activities. Guests can relax and reinvigorate in our cozy inn.
